Why?

Smooth passenger and cargo traffic movement through airport operations is essential to the aviation industry's operational efficiency. With the increase in the usage of air transport, the aviation industry must cater to the ever growing demand for smooth and reliable ground operations.

Aviation professionals have to keep abreast of changes in procedures and technology to achieve the highest degree of operational delivery, as expected by aviation industry stakeholders.

About the Programme

This programme offers industry-focused subjects on ground handling operations and management, contemporary aviation issues, safeguarding the aviation industry, aviation logistics and passenger handling services.
